Who should come?

Got something which need some love and attention, but are a bit broken and you don't have time or skills to fix them? Don't throw them away! Bring them to our event, and our volunteers will try to repair it. We have a mix of experts and beginners willing to get stuck in so that they share their repair skills and knowledge, you can save money, we all prevent waste, and reduce our resource consumption footprint. Even if we can't fix it, you'll still have a great time learning more and meeting new people! We run these events as part of the global repair café movement: www.repaircafe.org

Why do I need to book?

We will accept bookings for **only one item** that you would like mended - so as many people as possible can have an item repaired. We have a booking system that should guarantee a go at repairing your item! It also means that you will roughly know your estimated repair time, without waiting for too long. If you wish, you can bring **one other** item and we will add them to a 'Maybe' queue!

I don't have access to the internet – can I still bring my item?

We appreciate that not everyone has access to the internet. We've allocated the last hour for non-booked repairs. If you come early to book in your item, and are happy to wait or return for 16:00 – 17:00, we may have enough time left.

What items can I book / bring?

You can bring any household good that you can carry! We hope to be able to cover repairs such as electrical, mechanical, sharpening, sewing, bikes and more! If your item is too difficult to repair, or we don't have enough time, we will let you know when booking. **Please note** that we can't promise to repair. We will do our best and to advise on alternatives.

Help us to help you!

Please bring all parts that would help us test the repair such as: power cords, mains adaptors, CDs, remote controls, etc. You may wish to bring cash in case we have any necessary replacement parts available.

Can I come even if I don't have anything to fix?

Yes! We want to raise awareness of repairing and reusing instead of 'throwing away', so please come and watch volunteers perform the repairs and learn from them.
